Enter and View volunteers will be trained in how to carry out this work and exercise their powers appropriately using guidelines as set down by the Department of Health!

The volunteer role consists of:

- Undertake Enter & View training delivered by Healthwatch Barking and Dagenham
- Prepare for visits to health and social care services by researching and reading background information about the service being visited. (E.g. CQC Report, Website etc.)
- Visit health and social care premises to find out how services are delivered collecting the view of service users (patients and residents) at the point of service
- To take part in follow-up visits, after an initial visit has taken place

Skills and Experience required:

- Have a good understanding of confidentiality
- Be able to act professionally and represent Healthwatch Barking and Dagenham to a high standard
- Be able to follow guidance and instructions
- Be able to work in a team
- Reliable and good time keeping
- Good listening skills
- Good written and spoken English
- Empathy for others and a friendly personality
