The volunteer role consists of:

- Represent a group/ward within the borough of Barking & Dagenham and gather people's views on local health and social care services (for example via questionnaires and assisting with focus groups), feeding findings back to the Healthwatch team
- Promote Healthwatch Barking and Dagenham events and projects to local people in your area or to the group you represent
- Support Healthwatch staff with promotional stands within your ward and across the borough
- Attend and take part in Healthwatch volunteer training
- Inspire and actively connect people within the ward/group you represent to engage with Healthwatch

Skills and Experience required:

- Have a good understanding of confidentiality
- Be able to follow guidance and instructions
- Have good verbal and written communication skills
- Be able to work in a team
- Reliable and good at time keeping
- Good listening skills and empathy for others
- Able to separate own experiences from other people's issues - and faithfully present the views of your group
